

## ANGLE GRINDERS



They're ideal for various cutting and grinding jobs and come with varying power.

The Skil 9030AA, rated 600 W, is a small angle grinder that's perfect for basic home use. With its compact, durable metal gear housing it allows you easy access to those narrow, tough-to-reach places. It features an anti-slip grip for comfort and safety. Another safety feature is its security slider switch for safe operation even with gloves.

For more heavy-duty cutting and grinding jobs get your hands on the Skil 9780AA angle grinder with a 2 000 W power rating. It offers higher tolerance for extreme working conditions, high quality components to ensure long-term reliability and durability, and a slide handle that can be mounted in three positions.



## CORDLESS DRILL

A product such as the Skil 2006AB cordless drill driver is ideal for everyday jobs around the home such as hanging pictures, screwing in cupboard hinges or putting together that garden furniture kit you just bought. When it comes to DIY jobs, this drill is your best friend.

The 12V cordless drill driver is portable and has 20 torque positions for precise drilling and a full lock position that ensures the drill bit doesn't move while you're drilling.

The chuck, which is used to tighten the drill bit into the drill, is keyless for quick, easy accessory changes and the drill has reverse action for removing screws and bolts.

## IMPACT DRILLS

These drills vary in input power – the tougher the job, the more juice you'll need.

The Skil 6002AA drill with 500 W input power is lightweight and easy to use. It's suitable for most jobs around the home and produces enough power to drill through hard surfaces. For ordinary drilling and screwdriving jobs, the impact function can be switched off. The drill offers a reverse function for unscrewing and a lock-on button for continuous work.

The Skil 6495MA impact drill has 1 100 W input power for extra kick. When you're doing bigger, higher-impact drilling jobs, this is the model for you.



## PNEUMATIC HAMMER DRILLS

Drilling through concrete can be a tough job – and if you want to do it right you'll need a drill that's up to the challenge.

With a power rating of 750 W, the Skil 1758AA pneumatic hammer drill can get through concrete effortlessly. It has an SDS Plus drill bit system to allow for fast and easy bit changes, a rotation stop system function for light chiselling applications and up to 18 mm drilling capacity into concrete.
