

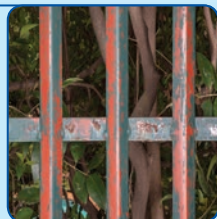
RUST PROOFING AND PAINTING PALISADE

PROJECT RATING:
VERY EASY



STEP 1

- First, protect your painted plaster and surrounding gardens with newspaper or pvc sheets.
- Remove flaking paint with a quality paint remover such as Alcolin or Fixit paint stripper and follow the manufacturer's instructions carefully.



STEP 2

- Sand and smooth the surface, then apply a good rust treatment. Duram Rustbuster is recommended for rust removal. Do not use a rust treatment on galvanised iron.

STEP 3

- Clean the section thoroughly and apply a metal primer like Medal Dual Steel Primer.
- Always start painting at the top of the fence so that you can fix any drips or runs as you work your way down.



STEP 4

- Allow the primer to dry thoroughly.
- When the primer is completely dry, apply good quality enamel based paint to the palisade. Dulux and Duram gloss enamels are both ideal paints for palisade fences.

STEP 5

- Make sure that there is nothing that causes a build-up of water underneath your palisade fence, as this will cause the fence to rust.
- Repair chipped paint as soon as you notice it - this will prolong the life of your fence and save time.
