GUARANTEE

Duram Armatex comes with an 8-year quality guarantee. To maintain the guarantee, only use Duram Colourants in Duram tint bases, with Duram Primers and Undercoats. To register your guarantee and for the terms and conditions, call the Duram Technical Helpline on 0800 500 222 or visit duram.co.za within 30 days of purchase.



SURFACE PREPARATION

Ensure all substrates are thoroughly clean, sound, dry and free from any contaminants such as dirt, rust, salt, algae, fungi, oil, grease and loose, flaking paint.

NEW SURFACES

- Cement plaster, fibre-cement, concrete, cement brickwork and clay brickwork: The moisture content must be less than 10% or have aged for at least 28 days prior to priming. Prime with *Duram Cement Primer* or *Duram Plaster Primer* as per instructions.
- Gypsum plaster and composite boards: The moisture content must be less than 10% or have aged for at least 28 days prior to priming. Prime with *Duram Plaster Primer* as per instructions.

PREVIOUSLY PAINTED SURFACES

- Sound surfaces: Apply topcoat direct to clean, sound Acrylics. Sand Enamels to a matt finish, dust off, and apply *Duram Universal Undercoat* as per instructions.
- Powdery or flaking surfaces: Remove powdery or loose, flaking paint completely with a wire brush, sandpaper or high-pressure cleaner. Rinse and allow to dry. Prime with the appropriate primer as for New Surfaces.



APPLICATION

- Ensure the appropriate Duram primer or undercoat has been used.
- Stir *Duram Armatex* well using a flat paddle.
- Thinning is not recommended.
- Apply two or more coats evenly with a brush or medium to heavy pile roller using long, smooth strokes. Do not apply with a stippled
- roller as temperature and slight viscosity variations can
- cause texture variances. It is ideal to paint the edges first
- using a brush, then paint the rest of the wall using a roller.
- Drying time between coats: 4- 6hrs.



CLEANING

• Water clean-up.



COLOUR

- While Duram makes every effort to ensure that colours shown match paint colours as closely as possible, variations may occur due to a variety of factors.
- This product is available for Duram colour tinting, using high performance colourants and top-quality tint bases. Simply pick your colour from the Duram Colour Wall or other colour reference, and the Colour Tinting Consultant at the paint counter will provide you with the finished product. Ensure that containers are tightly closed before transportation.
- Standard colours are filled to the volume shown on the packaging. Tint bases are underfilled to allow for colourants to be added at point of sale, together approximately making the volume shown on the packaging.
- Tint bases are not recommended to be used without the addition of the colourant. Only Duram Colourants are to be used in order to control colour accuracy and quality.
- For consistency of sheen and colour, always check that paint containers carry the same batch number.
- Always paint a test patch of the selected colour on your wall.

IMPORTANT

- Call our Technical Helpline or visit duram.co.za for queries and updated Datasheets and Material Safety Datasheets.
- Dry paint colour and sheen may vary from colour label.
- This product is available for Duram colour tinting. Tint bases are underfilled to allow for colourants to be added at point of sale. Only Duram Colourants are to be used.
- Check that paint containers carry the same batch number.
- Take care when lifting and carrying. In transit, keep tightly closed in a secure upright position.
- Whilst every care is taken in manufacture, no warranty is given relating to use.
- Do not mix with Mineral Turpentine
- Do not apply outside if rain is expected. Apply when ambient and surface temperatures are 5°C to 35°C.
- Keep cool and protect against freezing.
- Donate unwanted paint. Dispose contents responsibly do not empty into drains or watercourses. Recycle empty container.



SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

- Duram Armatex is water-based and is generally safe to use.
- Keep out of reach of children.
- If swallowed: Immediately call a poison centre / doctor.
- If on skin: Wash with plenty of soap and water.
